

Abstract

The assignment that worked so perfectly last year is getting done by ChatGPT instead of your students. The app you thought would streamline your classes was discontinued. The free service that saved you so much time now requires a paid subscription. But while it's true that some things are constantly changing, other things are not—like the place of language in society and importance of education and teachers. This session focuses on asking ourselves the right questions as we update our curriculum and approaches, to make sure that every year, every month, every week, and every lesson, we are helping our students towards their goals.
