Abstract: Using Bloom's Taxonomy to Help Students Bloom!

The distinction between 'studying' and 'learning' can be unclear in our learners' minds, with them often believing that because they have studied a language point, they must know it. Many of us will have experienced a student successfully completing their present perfect task and exclaiming 'Teacher, I finish!' This session will look at how we can raise students' awareness of the steps required to truly learn new language so that it is adopted into their everyday production. To do this, we will be using Bloom's taxonomy as a reference in order to ensure we are choosing appropriate activities that will push students forward in their language development, and will consider how we can move the student mindset away from 'studying' and more towards 'learning'.
