A Boring Lesson vs A Fun Lesson

There have been many studies done on the learning preference of students. There have also been many studies done on the importance of differentiation within lessons. It is a very daunting task for teachers to prepare for the 5 or 6 lessons a day in different subject areas when considering preferred learning styles and differentiation. Sometimes it is easier to prepare worksheets and consider only differentiation rather than to have to consider preferred learning styles as well. This scenario more often results in 'a boring lesson'.
