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TITLE:

CLICK, CREATE, COLLECT: TURN LESSON IDEAS INTO LIVE PRACTICE SITES

Abstract

What if every teacher could turn a lesson idea into a working, interactive exercise their students open on any phone — before the next class, and without writing a single line of code? This hands-on workshop reframes the teacher's role from technician to designer: you coach the brief, and Claude writes the HTML, CSS, and JavaScript. Working through a three-part loop — Click, Create, Collect — participants learn to craft a precise pedagogical brief (topic, level, exercise type, number of questions, feedback, and mobile-first format), generate and refine a self-contained interactive exercise, and publish it as a live link in seconds using Netlify Drop. The finished exercise checks each answer instantly and shows students their feedback and final score, turning every practice task into immediate self-assessment. Through guided practice, each participant leaves the session with a published exercise site of their own and a repeatable recipe for grammar and vocabulary drills, reading-comprehension checks, and quick self-tests. The workshop demonstrates that creating shareable, interactive learning tools requires neither technical expertise nor a coding background — only a clear teaching goal and the confidence to describe it — empowering EFL educators to produce responsive, student-facing digital materials that give learners instant, actionable feedback.
